And it is now broadly acknowledged that any leader empowered with the techniques, science and wisdom of a meditation practice will be able to develop higher energy and vision, empathetic values, friendly and intuitive approach, responsible execution ability.

Helping business leaders

Small and Medium Enterprises account for the majority of businesses worldwide and are important contributors to job creation and global economic development. They represent about 90% of businesses and more than 50% of employment worldwide. In India alone, 63+ million companies are *MSMEs* (*Micro, Small and Medium enterprises*), contributing to significant amount of GDP and producing 100 million jobs.

Sustainability and growth are on-going challenges. According to the US Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS), approximately 20% to 30% of new businesses fail during the first two years of being open, 45% during the first five years, and 65% during the first 10 years, causing much frustration and significant challenges to their leadership, employees and stake holders. These statistics have been quite consistent in these last 30 years and are quite similar across the world.

It is obvious that the success rate of these companies is vital for any economy to prosper and grow. Through proposing meditation wisdom and techniques with a scientific voice, our Foundation is willing to help all leaders and entrepreneurs – from very small to very large organizations -- to overcome their challenges and achieve their growth plans successfully.

Helping non-profit organizations leaders

The necessity of success and growth is the same for the non-profit sector. It is estimated that there are more than 10 million non-profits and non-governmental registered organizations worldwide. And this sector is growing. It is estimated that about 7% of the people in the world are working for non-profits in some way or the other and are touching the lives of billions of people and the planet.

The US non-profit sector alone employs approximately 12 million people (one out of every 10 working Americans), making it the third largest employment industry in the country. More than 60 million Americans volunteer their time with nonprofits.

But non-profit organizations are also facing sustainability challenges. The US National Center on Charitable Statistics indicates that about 30% of nonprofits fail to exist after 10 years. According to Forbes, over 50% of all nonprofits that are chartered are destined to fail or stall within a few years due to leadership issues and the lack of a strategic plan, among other things.

It is vital that these charitable non-profit organizations succeed to serve hundreds of million people around the world, as well as the environment and the planet in general. Our Foundation is willing to help their leaders and volunteers through the practice of meditation.

The essential role of leadership

Because a leader plays such an essential role, it is essential for every leader to know well himself / herself so to secure the success of his / her teams and the organization. Leadership – CEO / Founders / Leaders – need to have compassion in order to be sympathetic, inspiring and responsible to others. A leader who is limited by rigid beliefs, thinking or values can almost never succeed in growing a sustainable business or organization neither creating more resources for others. A leader that tends to act greedy or with excessive control over teams can hardly ever enable others to innovate and contribute to the organization growth. A leader certainly needs vision and clarity in strategy to deliver performance and make a difference.

4. To establish meditation training centers
